The three of them coexist in the solitude of the night, each facing in their own way the fear of revealing their vulnerability.

This is the story of her desire to meet her son, and what happens when that desire meets an unexpected obstacle.

One morning she reveals that she was inspired by Rabindranath Tagore's *Gora* and believes the character guides her to serve the country.

FLESH OUT


Dir – Armin Assadipour France, 2023, 17:00
